Note: 1. For Categories Nos.27 to 38 candidates holding Diploma / Degree in Engineering are not Eligible. 2. Vacancies of Ex-Servicemen given in the table are not separate but included in the total number of vacancies. 3. For posts of Section Engineer and Junior Engineer there could be online examination. 4. The written examination for Section Engineer and Junior Engineer is likely to be conducted on the same date/time. Candidates should keep this point in view while applying for the posts. 5. Candidates applying for category No. 26 (i.e. Assistant Loco Pilot) have to enclose a medical certificate from a Registered Eye specialist regarding vision in the format given in Annexure IV of the application. Otherwise their applications will be rejected. Only those candidates who conform to the standards of vision given in the format need to apply.

1. **ABBREVIATIONS:** SC - Scheduled Castes, ST - Scheduled Tribes, OBC - Other Backward Classes, UR - Unreserved, EXS - Ex-Servicemen, Cat - Category, OH - Orthopedically Handicapped, HH - Hearing Handicapped, VH - Visually Handicapped.

2. **MODE OF SELECTION:** For the Categories Nos.1 to 25 and 27 to 38 there will be single stage written examination followed by verification of original documents. For Cat No.26 there will be single stage written examination followed by aptitude test and verification of documents. The Railway Recruitment Board at its discretion may hold a second stage written examination, if considered necessary for all or limited number of candidates as may be deemed fit, in respect of the above notified categories of posts.

3. **AGE:** AGE FOR ALL CATEGORIES WILL BE RECKONED AS ON 01.07.2008.

4.1 The upper age limit in case of candidate who is a Course Completed Act Apprentice is 35 years for Category Nos. 26 to 38 provided the apprenticeship training commenced before the age of 25 years.

4.2 Candidates belonging to reserved communities are not eligible for age relaxation when posts are not reserved for them. However they can apply against unreserved vacancies.

5.0 **SALARY AND OTHER BENEFITS:** Selected candidates will be absorbed in working posts after successful completion of training wherever prescribed. The monthly emoluments on initial appointment will be on the minimum of the scale of pay plus Dearness Allowance. In addition, employees are also eligible for House Rent Allowance/City Compensatory Allowance, depending on the place of posting. They will be considered, in due course, for promotions to higher grades according to rules in force.

6.0 RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

6.1.1 The syllabus for the written examination will generally be in conformity with the educational qualifications prescribed for the post concerned. The written examination will be of objective type with multiple-choice questions in General Knowledge, General Intelligence/Reasoning and Analytical abilities and in Technical subjects related to the post applied for.

6.1.2 **IMPORTANT -** The Railway Recruitment Board at their discretion may hold a common examination for more than one category if considered necessary. The Railway Recruitment Board at its discretion may hold additional written examination(s) or re-examination(s) or second stage written examination, if considered necessary for all or limited number of candidates as may be deemed fit, in respect of the above notified categories of posts. In such cases the merit secured in such in subsequent examination alone will be the criteria for further recruitment process.

6.1.3 Merely satisfying the age and educational qualifications itself will not constitute a right to be called for the written examination unless the candidate fulfills all other conditions/requirements given in this Employment Notice.

6.1.4 Candidates may please note that examinations of more than one category may be held on any particular date, due to which the date and time of some categories may clash. While making application candidates should bear this fact in mind. In such case it is for the candidate to decide to choose the category to which he/she wants to appear for. No

request for change of time, date and centre of examination will be entertained. No claim of refund of fees and other expenses will be entertained in such situations.

6.1.5 The candidature and the conditions specified here are subject to change at any stage by the Railway Administration by orders subsequently issued having retrospective effect. Such changes will be notified in the Employment News/Roger Samachar and will be binding on all candidates.

7. **EXAMINATION CENTRES:** The written examinations will normally be held in Secunderabad / Hyderabad. However examinations will also be conducted in other cities if a need arises.

8.0 EXAMINATION FEES

8.1 **FEES PARTICULARS:** Candidates belonging to SC, ST communities, Ex-Servicemen/Physically Challenged candidates are fully exempted from payment of examination fees. Other candidates should pay the requisite fees.

8.2 **MODE OF PAYMENT:** To be paid in the form of a crossed Demand Draft (DD) on scheduled banks or through crossed Indian Postal Order (IPO) (purchased on or after the date of publication of the Employment Notice) drawn in favour of the Assistant Secretary, Railway Recruitment Board, Secunderabad (A.P.) and payable at Secunderabad. Applications without IPO/DDs of the requisite value as mentioned above will be treated as invalid and summarily rejected.

8.3 The candidate should write the following details in the space provided for sender's name in the case of postal order and on the reverse side in the case of demand draft.

8.4 The examination fee is not refundable/transferable/adjustable for any other examination under any circumstance including partial or total cancellation of examination.

9.0 HOW TO APPLY:

9.1 **ONLINE REGISTRATION OF APPLICATIONS:** The facility of online registration of applications is also available on website www.rrbsec.org (or) www.rrbsecunderabad.org. Candidates wishing register on line should (a) Log on to the website and register online. (b) Download the filled in application duly signed, affix Left Thumb Impression and photograph, put in the specimen signatures, reproduce the paragraph in the space given and attach requisite enclosures and fees (if applicable) and send the same to reach RRB office on or before 17.03.2008 duly superscribing "ONLINE" application on the envelope.

9.2 Candidates should carefully read all the instructions before filling in the application form. Application(s) shall be made on good quality white plain A4 size 80 GSM bond paper in the format given in this Employment Notice. Separate application should be made for each category of post with requisite postal order/demand draft of the prescribed value as well as set of enclosure as required for the category and sent in separate covers. The application format can also be downloaded from websites www.rrbsec.org or www.rrbsecunderabad.org. Photocopies of the application format appearing in the notification can also be used. Applications not in A-4 size paper will be rejected.

9.3 The application should be filled in with bold/capital letters either in English or Hindi only, duly dated and signed by the Candidate. It should be with specimen signatures at the places provided for in the application form. Application filled by any other person on behalf of candidate/any change in the format of the application will lead to rejection of application. Please note that details of name, father's name, and address, nearest railway station, identification marks and declaration should be written in English only. Only Arabic numerals (i.e. 1, 2, and 3) should be used. It is essential that complete address with district, State and PIN code is given in the application form.

9.4 Signature of the applicant must be full and specific. The signatures of the candidate at the end of the application, in the personal data sheet, the specimen signatures and the signature in the box below the pasted photo should all be identical and there should be no variation. Signatures in different languages and in different styles in different places will render the application invalid.

9.5 One copy of latest passport size black and white photograph (with the candidate wearing white or very light colour garments and without wearing cap and sunglasses) which should be not more than three months old should be pasted on the application form. Please note that the same photograph should be used for any subsequent stages whenever called for. If different photographs are submitted at different stages or if more than one application is received with different photographs, the applications will be rejected. Candidates may note that the RRB may reject at any stage for pasting old/unclear photograph on the application and for any significant variations between photograph pasted in the application and the actual physical appearance of the candidate.

9.6 Each candidate should send only one application for one category of post, unless a single application is prescribed for more than one category. Wherever common application is called for more than one category the candidate should clearly indicate the categories for which he wishes to be considered. Candidates submitting

- duplicate applications for any category will be disqualified and liable to be debarred for a period of 2 years from appearing in any examination conducted by any Railway Recruitment Board over the Indian Railways.
- 9.7 Candidates should affix their left thumb impression in the spaces provided for in the application. The impression should be clear and not smudged.
- 9.8 **Declaration:** A declaration has to be filled up by the candidate in his/her own handwriting in English and every word of the declaration in the application form has to be reproduced in the space provided. Failure to fill the declaration in full will lead to rejection of the application.
- 10.0 **WHOM TO ADDRESS:** The filled-in application along with its enclosures should be sent by ordinary post only in a cover addressed to The Assistant Secretary, Railway Recruitment Board, South Lallaguda, Secunderabad - 500 017, (A.P.) to reach him on or before the last date. No courier/registered post/parcel/speed post will be accepted under any circumstances. The covers containing applications can also be personally deposited at Railway Recruitment Board's Office, Secunderabad during working hours on or before the last date.
- 10.1 The cover should be clearly super-scribed in bold capitals "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF _____ CATEGORY No. _____ Employment Notice No. _____".
- 10.2 Railway Recruitment Board, Secunderabad will not be responsible for any postal delay or wrong deliveries. Candidates sending their applications by post are advised to post their applications sufficiently in advance so that they reach Railway Recruitment Board on or before the closing date.
- 11.0 **GENERAL CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT:**
- 11.1 The number of vacancies indicated is provisional and may vary or even come NIL depending upon the actual needs of the administration. The Railway Recruitment Board also reserves the right to cancel all the notified vacancies for any category or categories at its discretion depending upon the needs of the Administration and such decision will be final and binding. In the event of the cancellation of the notified vacancies, no refund of examination fee paid by the candidates for that category will be made.
- 11.2 Before applying for any post the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility norms. The candidates should possess the requisite qualification for the post applied for at the time of application itself. Candidates acquiring the qualifications after the date of application shall not be considered eligible.

Choice asked for the Railway is only for guidance of the Railway Recruitment Board, Secunderabad. Allotment of Railway to selected candidates will be at the discretion of the Railway Recruitment Board. No particular Railway or place can be assured.

- 12.0 **SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT:**
- 12.1 Recruitment process is subject to caste based reservation. For this purpose, caste certificate from competent authorities in the case of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Other Backward Class candidates should invariably accompany the application. The specimen format for OBC certificate is at Annexure-I and for SC/ST communities is at Annexure-II. Applications of candidates belonging to SC/ST communities without relevant caste certificate will be rejected.
